A State-level workshop on ‘NER District SDG Index 2.0, SDG India Index 4.0 and MPI’ was held at the Capital Convention Centre, Kohima on 12th April 2022. The workshop was jointly organized by Sustainable Development Goals Coordination Centre under Planning & Coordination Department, NITI Aayog, and United Nations Development Programme. The program was attended by all the concerned State departments. The State -level workshop was graced by Shri. Imnatiba, Hon’ble Advisor for Industries & Commerce, Labour & Employment, Skill Development & Entrepreneurship, Government of Nagaland.

The key objective of the workshop was to discuss the methodology, indicators, data sources, updated data of the SDG Indexes and MPI, and areas of improvement.

NITI Aayog carried out the technical sessions of the workshop. The first technical session was on SDG India Index 2020-21, the National Multidimensional Poverty Index, and the context setting on the second edition of NER SDG Index 2.0. The second technical session focuses on the detailed analysis of the SDG Index 2020-21 and NER SDG Index 2020-21 and discussions with the concerned State Departments on district-wise data reporting, challenges and way forward.
